Our Services

HealthLink provides primary dental care for patients who meet our eligibility requirements.

Services include:

- oral exams
- radiographs (x-rays)
- restorations (fillings)
- dental hygiene
- simple extractions
- patient education

When patients require care beyond what we can provide on-site, our staff will attempt to make referrals to local specialists. A fee may be required for services provided off-site.

HealthLink does not provide walk-in care or handle emergency situations. If you have an emergency, please visit your nearest emergency department.





Become A Patient

Eligibility requirements must be met to receive free dental care.

HealthLink patients must:

- Be between 18 and 65 years of age.
- Live in either Bucks or Montgomery Counties.
- Not have any form of dental insurance.
- Be currently employed.
- Earn less than 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines

Eligibility will be reviewed prior to the first visit and annually in the Spring.

Patients must continue to show proof of meeting all eligibility requirements each year to continue receiving care.



Your First Appointment

An eligibility appointment must be scheduled first before a patient can receive care.

At a patient's first appointment, he/she must provide the following documents:

- Photo ID (driver's license, passport, or work ID)
- Proof of residency (lease agreement or utility bill)
- Most recent 2 months of pay stubs
- Completed/Signed federal tax return for the current year (Form 1040 and any Schedules)

If a patient is deemed eligible for our services, they can schedule their initial visit to be seen by a dentist.
